











Creating Reliability Records

When you have completed the clinical audit, we ask your site to enter 3-5 reliability records.




Each reliability case is derived from an original patient record and it is to be entered into the AuSDaT in the same way as the original record/episode but by another auditor. This process allows us to monitor whether the questions are being interpreted the same way and provides feedback to us on what questions can be improved or changed in future audits.

- Click on **Patient record management** and search for the patient record you wish to perform a reliability record on. Click on **Patient record view**
- **NB.** If you use other programs (i.e. **AuSCR**), to save time, ensure that you toggle between the AuSDaT programs 'hidden' and 'shown' and **'Show'** only *National Audit of Rehabilitation Stroke Services 2020*
- Also, if you use other programs on the AuSDaT certain sections may still appear as **amber** if acute variables for other programs (i.e. **AuSCR**) still require a value. This will not impact your ability to **'Close'** the patient record for the *National Audit of Rehabilitation Stroke Services 2020*

- When the original patient record has every *National Audit of Rehabilitation Stroke Services 2020* variable entered, it will have **Completeness** of 100% in **green** (see below)

- The Hospital Coordinator must then **‘Close’** the record to allow you to open a reliability record. **NB.** status of the patient record for any other programs (i.e. **AuSCR**) will remain ‘open’ and other clinicians can still return to the record and amend variables for the other program

- Once the patient record has been **‘closed’** for the initial *Rehabilitation Stroke Services Audit 2020*, check the **Record attributes** and you will have the option to **Create a reliability record**
- To start your reliability, record a separate auditor for that patient record is to log-in to the AuSDaT and locate the record in **Patient record management**.

- All *National Audit of Rehabilitation Stroke Services 2020* variables for this patient record will be re-fresh for the new auditor to enter data
- The new reliability auditor is to provide a response to all the Clinical Audit variables and each section will turn green as you complete it
- When you have finished, click **Return to view** and return to the **Patient record management** screen and the record is complete (there will not be an option to '**Close**' a reliability case)
- On the **Patient record view** screen, you should see a pink message at the top of your screen

- On the **Patient record management** screen, you will see a pink '**R**' next to the patient record that you have just re-audited. This means that a reliability case has been successfully created
- The audit team will now export these cases for an intra-variability study after the rehabilitation audit data collection period has expired
